? Who is the programme aimed at?

? How will this programme be delivered?

i Graduates of this programme will:

- Distinguish behaviors that are part of normal development from those that are different from normal development.
- Explain principles of assessment, diagnosis and treatment of patients of all ages and their families presenting to child psychiatric services.
- Identify the common signs of mental health problems in children.
- Discuss the relationship between physical, cognitive, emotional, social and developmental factors that contribute to emotional and behavioral difficulties or more serious mental illness.

Identify the signs and symptoms of common mental health challenges in children and young people, and differentiate between typical developmental behaviors and potential mental health concerns.
Neuro-developmental Disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the diagnostic criteria, characteristics, and impact of neurodevelopmental disorders such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). Analyze evidence-based strategies for supporting children and adolescents with neurodevelopmental disorders in educational, familial, and social contexts.
Emotional & Mood Disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognize the symptoms, risk factors, and diagnostic criteria for emotional and mood disorders in children and adolescents. Evaluate the role of family, school, and community environments in the development and management of emotional and mood disorders.
Somatic symptoms, Obsessive Compulsive Disorders, Tic disorder & Behavior Problems	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Differentiate between somatic symptom disorders, obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), tic disorders, and behavioral problems, and explain their impact on daily functioning. Develop strategies for early identification and intervention for children and adolescents experiencing somatic symptoms, OCD, tic disorders, or behavioral challenges.
Miscellaneous Disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify less common but significant mental health disorders in children and adolescents, such as eating disorders, trauma-related disorders, and psychotic disorders. Discuss the importance of culturally sensitive and individualized approaches to assessment and treatment for miscellaneous mental health disorders.
Child Mental health Treatments and Emergencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compare evidence-based treatment modalities for child and adolescent mental health disorders. Recognize and respond to mental health emergencies in children and adolescents using appropriate crisis intervention techniques.
